## Virtual tourfor tenants

PROSPECTIVE tenants of a leading Welsh housing association will soon be able to take a tour of their potential new home without having to leave their own house.

Caerphilly-based United Welsh Housing Association (UWHA) has become the first housing association in Wales to launch online virtual tours of its properties, an innovative scheme which allows prospective applicants and tenants to view locations, houses and flats without having to visit them.

Made possible by more than £38,000 of funding over three years from the National Assembly for Wales, the facility will be accessible via UWHA's website, will feature photographs of the areas where UWHA has housing and will show typical Association houses and flats along with information on the property, location and amenities.
